Required coursework includes 18 units:

- Child Growth and Development (CHILD-1)
- Principles & Practices of Teaching Young Children (CHILD-3)
- Child, Family, Community (CHILD-22)
- Health, Safety & Nutrition (CHILD-26)
- Infant/Toddler Development (CHILD-42)
- Infant/Toddler Care and Education (CHILD-43)

Application Procedures:

- Apply to the Columbia College Apprenticeship Initiative
- Apply for Financial Aid/FAFSA
- Apply to an employer partner
- Follow hiring procedure as outlined by each employer and successfully obtain employment
- Meet with Apprenticeship staff for course registration and on-boarding
